

Project 3418 – Statement of Faith

We believe:

- The Bible is the divinely inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God, and is the foundation for all we believe and do. (2 Timothy 3:16–17; 2 Peter 1:20–21)
- There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; John 1:1–3)
- Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was born of the virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, died for our sins, rose again on the third day, ascended into heaven, and will return for the church and again in power and glory. (Luke 1:35; 1 Corinthians 15:3–4; Acts 1:9–11)
- All people are made in the image of God and have inherent dignity, value, and purpose. As such, we seek to serve anyone in need, regardless of background, belief, or circumstance. (Genesis 1:27; Micah 6:8; Luke 10:25–37)
- Mankind as a consequence of the fall (sin) of Adam, became lost and at enmity with God (Romans 3:21–23; Romans 5:6, 12–19, Romans 8: 5–7).
- Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. All who repent and believe are forgiven, justified, and granted new life through the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 2:8–9; Romans 5:1; Titus 3:5)
- The Holy Spirit indwells and empowers all believers, enabling them to live holy lives and to serve others with love, humility, and boldness. (Romans 8:11; Galatians 5:22–23)
- The Church is the body of Christ made up of all believers. We affirm the unity of the global Church and the importance of fellowship, service, and worship. (1 Corinthians 12:12–13; Ephesians 4:4–6)

- The Great Commandment and Great Commission call us to love our neighbour and share the gospel. We believe that acts of compassion and justice are a natural outworking of Christian faith. (Matthew 22:36–40; Matthew 28:18–20; James 2:14–17)
- Practical expressions of the gospel – such as feeding the hungry, clothing the poor, offering kindness, and pointing people to Jesus – are central to our work. (Isaiah 58:6–10; Matthew 25:34–40)
